

# Privacy Policy

## Information I collect

I don't need to collect any information from you. If you save any settings in an application of mine, you are saving those to the device storage or your cloud account, not my servers or computers.

If you visit my website, your IP address is recorded to a log by my Internet Host. I don't do anything with those and most folks IP addresses change frequently by your ISP anyway.

When you use one of my apps, upon launch, Google records that usage. I don't and I don't capture anything you enter into the app.

## How I use information

Any usage information I collect is used to check trends of content or apps I have published, sometimes for my curiosity and sometimes to see if a change I made impeded usage.

## Your Choice

People have different privacy concerns. Quite frankly, if you are concerned with privacy, you have bigger concerns than visiting my website or downloading one of my apps.

## Information I share

I do not share anything with anyone. Domain administrators and Google do more tracking of IP addresses, but again, that is in their terms and conditions.
